Dr. Leo Nesmith, Task Assigned Chief Safety & Security Officer & Chief Craig Kowalski, Chief Special Investigative Unit – Wanding of Students & other safety concerns

The topic of metal detectors was first initiated after the tragedy at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School. The metal detectors utilized by the District is a handheld wand that will be used at school sporting events and other school activities. Across the country there has been an uptick in weapons being brought onto school campuses. Any time this occurs, parents will be notified. In order to address this increasing concern, the use of handheld wand style metal detectors will be implemented after security staff and administrators have been properly trained.

The wands will be used for randomized screening and as needed for possible threats. Randomized approach ensures that rights are preserved. Inception and scope are the parameters. Randomizing eliminates issues with profiling and bias. This policy was approved under the emergency rule but will return for one workshop and final adoption. Secondary schools are the focus, however, elementary is not excluded.

Both Dr. Nesmith and Chief Kolwalski are willing to come speak at all area meetings upon request and will return to the DAC on March 9th. The DAC sub-committee will be headed by Salif Dabo.

Mary Mulder, Director Food and Nutrition Services - Free and Reduced Lunch

Message sent to families has been updated to reflect importance for Title I services. Additionally, this department monitors many services including food allergens and sensitivities. Menus are planned with dieticians in coordination with the National Food Program guidelines. There is no outward identifier for free, reduced or full pay lunches. Status is completely confidential. Applications increased from about 300 to 1900 with the message change. They will repeat weekly on Fridays through the application deadline.

In a partnership with Feeding South Florida schools have the option to donate unopened food from students via a sharing table. Annually, the department holds student food shows where students are bussed in to sample and vote on menu items. This was placed on hold during COVID but will resume next school year. Currently, there are also 119 schools that are part of the supper program for students enrolled in afterschool camps/programs.
